












### Kings Forest Constraints Maps 2010 Scale: 1:25,000

-  Open or felled land
-  Leasehold Land  
Permission to use this land must be sought from landowner.
-  Public Right of Way (PROW)
-  Waymarked Trail
-  Fire Routes  
Emergency access routes: do not block.
-  Rifle Range - no entry at any time.
-  Compartment Boundary  
Access available throughout the year except when closed for Stone Curlew.
-  Nature Conservation Sites  
Rides with a conservation interest can be used, keeping to the centre of the track, avoiding the grass verges.
-  Conservation line
-  Conservation point
-  Young Crops  
Birds nesting - no entry into crops between 1 March and 30 September.
